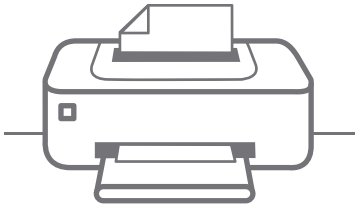

Print your image onto the opaque transfer paper (following the instructions for the product you are using)



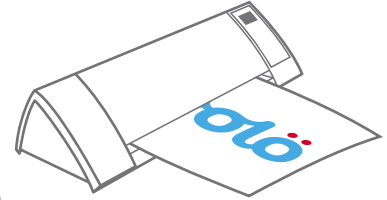

Leave the image for approximately **30 minutes** to allow the ink to dry



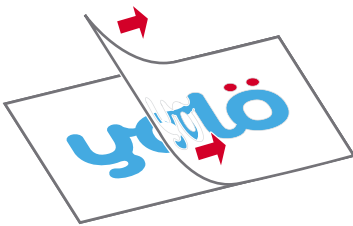

Cut your image using a contour/plotter cutter, ensuring the blade cuts through the transfer film only and not the backing paper



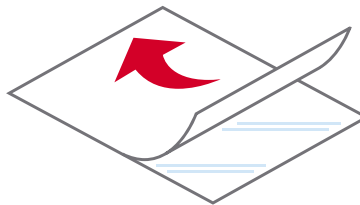

Weed away the unwanted film, leaving the image on the backing paper (a weeding tool may help)



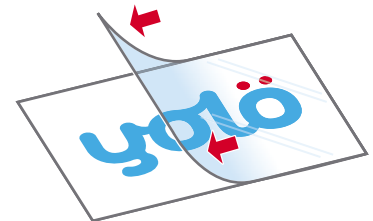

Prepare the transfer mask by removing the backing paper (you can discard the backing paper)



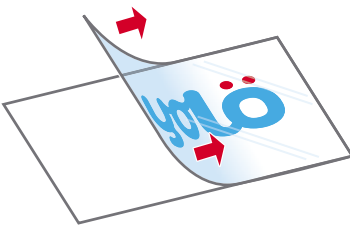

Lay the mask, sticky side down over the weeded image and press lightly



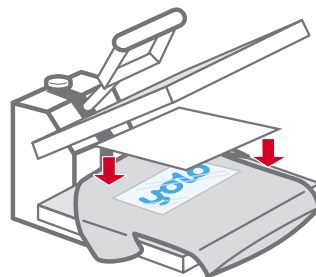

Slowly peel the mask off the backing paper to lift the image



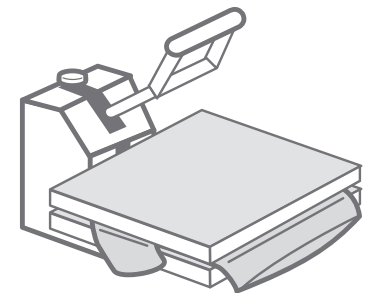

Place the mask with image face up on substrate and cover with a Teflon or silicone sheet

Press your image (following the instructions for the product you are using)

Peel when cold

24hrs before washing

yolo tips

Ensure you cut through the transfer film only and do not score the backing paper.

Setting the weeded image close to a heat press for a couple of seconds will make the image easier to lift.
